RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. DRUGS AND ALCOHOL

The possession of drugs and/or alcohol for non-medical purposes is ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED. Possession for these purposes is contrary to the CANADA CRIMINAL CODE AND THE NARCOTICS CONTROL ACT. Any person involved in such activity will be expelled from Camp.

2. FRATERNIZATION

Staff are not permitted to date campers. Counselors are not permitted to engage in any conduct with camper that is or may be perceived to be sexual or sensual in nature. In order to avoid any perception of inappropriate activity, counselors should not be alone in a private space with a camper of the opposite sex.

2. SMOKING

CAMP KADIMAH IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY. Campers, CITs and Staff are strictly prohibited from smoking anywhere on Camp grounds.

3. PRIVACY IN CABINS

Male campers and staff are not permitted in female cabins and vice versa. No camper or counselor should enter a Head Staff cabin without permission of the occupant of that cabin.

4. ZERO TOLERANCE

It is inappropriate for any person at camp to touch another person at camp in any manner considered unacceptable or unwanted by that camper. This includes anything that may be even remotely considered as physically or sexually abusive. Camp Kadimah has a zero tolerance policy for any violation of this rule. NO MEANS NO.

5. CURFEWS

All curfews will be strictly enforced, and may be extended only with the permission of the CAMP DIRECTOR. Giborim : 8:30 pm, Goshrim 9:00 pm, Kochot 9:30 pm, Machar 10:30 pm, CITs- 11:30 pm, Staff 12:30 am.

6. SHMIRA

Security is provided by the counseling staff.

7 RESTRICTED AREAS

Restricted areas include: a) Waterfront- except with the express permission of the Director (Waterfront rules will apply) b)Kitchen- except for Head buggy Duty. c) Tool shed- requests for equipment will be made directly to the Director. d) Infirmary- except during sick call and visitations as permitted by the Nurse.

8. CLEANLINESS

All waste papers and other materials should be placed in the appropriate trash cans and waste baskets distributed around the site and in the cabins. All campers and counselors will be held responsible for their cabins. Inspection will be held once each day; and a special weekly one on Erev Shabbat. Cabin of the week will be announced at Erev Shabbat mifkad.

9.MEALS

All groups are to proceed to assembly areas when called. Entry into the Chadar will be by units. Upon entering the Chadar Ochel, all will remain standing at their tables quietly until the opening bracha. When someone at the Head Table stands, there must be silence in order that the announcements will be heard by all.

ALL MALE CAMPERS AND STAFF ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR A HEAD COVERING AT MEALS.

Wet bathing suits, whether covered or not, are not permitted to be worn in the Chadar Ochel during meals. Waterfront staff will receive special instructions regarding this matter.

MEAL TIME SHOULD BE ENJOYABLE FOR ALL. UNDUE NOISE MAKES FOR A VERY UNPLEASANT ATMOSPHERE IN WHICH TO EAT AND HAMPERS DIGESTION. NOISE IN THE CHADAR OCHEL MUST BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM.

10. OUT OF BOUNDS

NO ONE IS PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE CAMP GROUNDS WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE CAMP DIRECTOR. Camp boundaries are as follows: Infirmary side- from the CIT area along the Highway fence to the gate; Office side- from the kitchen gates to the far side of the Rubin Cultural Centre.

11.SERVICES

Erev Shabbat and Shabbat services are compulsory for everyone.

12. TELEPHONE

Absolutely no phone calls IN or OUT, will be permitted without the authority of the Camp Director. Calls permitted OUT must be made COLLECT.

13.INFIRMARY

All campers going on sick call or for other medical needs during the day, MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY

A COUNSELLOR. The Doctor and Nurses have complete discretion as to visiting privileges and the number of visitors at any given time.

14. MENUCHA

Menucha is rest period and is expected to be observed as such by campers and staff. There will be a staff member with each bunk during the rest period. Sun bathing, sitting in the shade and quiet games indoors are allowed. Competitive games are not allowed at this time.

15. MAIL

Mail will be distributed once a day on week days. Campers must write at least three letters home each week. Letter writing is to be considered as part of the daily inspection.

16. VISITORS

No one from outside Camp (except members of the Camp Committee on camp business) may enter the Camp Grounds without the express permission of the Director.

17. LAUNDRY

Laundry will be collected at the Pavilion before Aruchat Boker (breakfast) once a week and returned on the same day the following week.

18. SNACKS

Snacks will be provided twice daily: Once in the mid-afternoon and again after the evening program.

19 RAIDS

Raids are not permitted.

20. MONEY AND VALUABLES

Camp will not assume responsibility for money or valuables that are not labeled and locked in the office.

22. CITS

CITS are campers with additional responsibilities. Their program will be outlined at camp.

23. CHEWING GUM

Chewing gum is NOT ALLOWED in the Dining Hall, on the Waterfront, in the Ulam or in the Rubin Cultural Centre.

24. GENERAL SWIM

General swim is compulsory for all campers and staff. Everyone must report to the Waterfront in bathing suits and with their towel and sweatshirt or dressed appropriately. No bare feet.
