themselves but without causing more problems.



Masada symbolizes not a physical fortress engraved in barren Judean, desert rock, but a spiritual survival throughout Jewish history despite incredible oppression. Masada symbolizes the Jewish pride and identity and a will to fight and defeat all persecuting factors.

Throughout Jewish history, the Jews have encountered obstacles to their survival. These obstacles express themselves through wars, inquisitions and nations and span from the most ancient to the most recent of times. The Jews, always the tempersecuted minority have had to fight for their identity and though many have perished in the last two thousand years including the six million of the Holocaust, the Jewish nation has not yet succumbed to assimilation or destruction. Often, many Jews died actively during brave rebellions and self sacrificing revolutions. The revolts may be seen as early as the Greek occupation of Israel. Many Jews refused to accept the Hellinization and as a result died in their adament refusals. Chava and her seven sons is a classic example of this determination and fight for the Jewish heritage and identity. They refused ot eat the pork forced on them by the Greeks and consequently died. However, a death like this may never be condidered a defeat, rather a victory, because it maintains the c ntinuity of the Jewish tradition

During the Roman occupation of Israel, the Jews were oppressed immeasurably, especially during Herod's reign. This persecution culminated in a Jewish war and the attack of Masada by Menahem son of Judah and his band of zealots. Eleazor, the son of Jair escaped to Masada with 960 men and women and took refuge there till it's defeat in 72 CE by the Roman governor Flaviyus Silva. The fact that Masada stood for so long is quite remarkable and most remarkable and most probable due to the tenacious grip of these zealots on their identiy and life. The fact that they committed suicide just before they penetrated their stronghold reinforces our belief in their great belief. The pride in their heritage was beyond death, so far s uperior that it was in another dimension. Their determination has been echoed throughout the ages and will cont nue to do so as long as the Jewish spirit continues.




