

Perhaps I should mention that I'm a dog for punishment (no reference to Kenny meant here) and that the same time next yearcouldvery well find me sitting here, trying to write another report.

For the friendships formed in such a short time, the kindness shown to me and Stefan, the smiles of thanks, the hugs, the acceptance so easily of a new face, the gratitude expressed with the eyes and without words — none of these will easily be forgotten by a big kid who was so homesick, she wanted to go home after the first week.

So my thanks and my love to all of you for making our first summer at Camp Kadimah so easy and so pleasant. May we all enjoy good health and happiness and short stays in the infirmary.

Dara she supplies the food, her bags are packed to go. Mitchell must have seen "E.T." 'cause he's got a funny toe.



Now that the summer is over you may be far away from your "second home" but your friendships and memories will remain in your hearts to cherish.


