Camp Kadimah's 60th Anniversary

As the 60th anniversary of Camp Kadimah rolls around, we'd like to take this opportunity to look back upon some of the tremendous improvements that have taken place here over the last 20 years. After all, at the time of the 40th anniversary reunion in 1984, it would have been virtually impossible to imagine all the developments that lay ahead in the next twenty years.

In 2004, the camp is slightly overcrowded, as as a package of land stretching from the tennis courts to the bonfire site had to be sold to some Toronto real estate developers. The luxury condominiums have an excellent view of the camp's waterfront, and of course the multi-story car park is available for staff parking dur-

ing the summer.

Campers and staff pass by the condominiums on their occasional trips to the "general store." The nickname "general store" has of course stayed in popular use; even though Mader's Red and White was replaced by a Dominion in 1994, and expanded into the Barss Corner Mall in 1999, with major occupants Eaton's, Simpson's and the Bay. Needless to say, many of our campers and staff feel much more at home in the air-conditioned comfort and excitement that the new mall provides.

For the lazier campers and counsellors, it is now possible to choose between the Barss Corner express bus that stops on the highway outside the former tennis courts, and the Barss Corner rapid transit subway system, that stops at Ulam Station and Barn Station.

As for the camp itself, the waterfront has been greatly improved by the introduction of computerized buddy tags and a photosensitive turnstile at the high tower. With the new solar heating panel that spans the lake, the waterfront is permanently heated. Thus the camp schedule no longer has to revolve around the gibbies getting their swim instruction last pe'ulah.

The newly installed permanent video and light show in the Ulam has made the Saturday night socials more popular than ever. And, as far as music goes, the hundred-meter broadcasting tower has great-

ly improved radio reception for CKBC all over Lunenburg County.

However, the broadcasting antenna is no longer the landmark it once was. It has been completely overshadowed by the Camp Committee Observation Tower which has just been built to replace the Machar Migdal. (Nobody seemed to know what the Migdal was for in the first place.) The Observation Tower is a large concrete, steel and reflective glass structure that allows the Camp Committee to observe all camper and staff activities both directly and via closed circuit television. With this new system, videotapes of suspect activities can be beamed by the Camp's satellite (Hafta'ah-1) directly to the Halifax office of the AJC for appropriate action.

Finally, it was unfortunate that Maccabia had to be cancelled for this season. Camp still maintained the excitement of a competitive sporting event, however, since Barss Corner was chosen as

the site of the 28th Olympic Summer Games for 2004.

At any rate, it is evident that the miracles of modern technology have brought numerous improvements to the quality of life at Camp Kadimah. Who knows what changes we can look forward to at the Camp's centennial?
